

Minutes of the NARRC Committee Meeting held
November 7, 2009 in Pittsburgh, PA

Attending: C. Franson, J. Hanifan, B. Introne, C. Morales, C. Mosley, D. Panas, D. Patullo, D. Perlman, J. Rigoli, J. Sheridan, E. Zebrowski

Panas: In looking at the Minutes of this past March's meeting in Rocky Hill, it was noted that New York Region was to hold the 2009 NARRC banquet.

Hanifan: There may be confusion here. Because the NARRC banquet was held last year in Albany, it was thought that Mo-Hud hosted it. It was actually NNJR. It goes alphabetically so in theory Mo-Hud would host it, but it will be at the New Jersey Roundtable.

General discussion as to whether NNJ would have the banquet at the March 2010 Roundtable. It was decided that the Saturday luncheon at the Roundtable would be the NARRC banquet.

Treasurer's Report

Kristine Mushnick, Treasurer, was not present, however it was noted that virtually no activity has taken place with the NARRC treasury since March, therefore the balance stands at approximately \$24,000.

Old Business

SportsCar Ad

At the March meeting a Motion was made to take out an ad in SportsCar to highlight the 2008 winners and promote the 2009 schedule. That was not done.

Winners Stickers

D. Anthony had said that the stickers could be completed in about two weeks after he gets the artwork. This information was apparently not passed on to Chris Mosley. Consequently there were no winners' stickers for 2009.

New Business

2010 NARRC Race Schedule

C. Morales noted that there are only three dates taken at Lime Rock Park. These dates are in May, June and October. General discussion followed regarding the possibility of taking another LRP date in the July – August time frame. **C. Morales** suggested that a pooling of Regions might be a good way to go into another LRP date. After discussion it was decided that past experience and the existing NEDiv schedule did not provide a good opportunity for another LRP date in 2010.

NER & NNJR (NJB) each have two races scheduled against each other. **J. Rigoli** suggested that NER would give up the Memorial Day double race at NHMS as a NARRC race and take the July 10-11 date as a NARRC race. In turn, the NJB would not take that date as a NARRC race. Subsequently, the NJB would take the August 21-22 date as a NARRC race and NER would not use that same date at NHMS as a NARRC race.

After further discussion a schedule was arrived at (see below) and it was decided that:

- All races will count for points.
- There will be no bonus points for any reason.
- In order to be eligible for a Championship you must achieve a race finish on a minimum of three weekends.
- Those finishes must be in the same class.
- If the NARRC Runoffs is your first NARRC race, you will not be counted for points. I.e. that finishing position will be skipped as if you were not there.

Awards

Based on last year's experience, there will be no NARRC fee per car in 2010. Awards will be jackets and trophies only. There will be no money awards. This is the same as in 2009.

Event Organization

A discussion was held outlining various methods of "running the weekend". This included various qualifying methods such as, straight qualifying sessions for each race; determining starting positions based on previous finishing position; determining starting positions based on a fast lap in the previous race, etc.

Discussion also centered on the inclusion of Pro-IT with NARRC races, and various expenses and entry fee structures. No major conclusions were arrived at.
