

Minutes of the NARRC Committee held March 13, 2010
In Florham Park, NJ

There was no Treasurer's Report given.

The dates and locations of the 2010 NARRC races were confirmed:

June 19 – Lime Rock – one day, single race
July 10-11 – New Hampshire – double race
July 24-25 – Watkins Glen – double race
August 21-22 – New Jersey – double race
Oct 1-2 – Lime Rock – single race, double points (NARRC Runoffs)

The only change from the dates chosen in November 2009 is the elimination (by the Region) of the Pocono Mothers Day weekend double race.

There was comment that some drivers had complained that there were no “drops”. The committee confirmed that the changes made from the 2009 series were to reduce the number of races, reduce the number of weekends, and to have drivers count all races for the 2010 Championship.

Discussion was held concerning the number of NARRC races that are run in conflict with other races held by NARRC Regions on the same weekend.

It was pointed out that the July 10-11 race to be held in New Jersey was primarily a MARRS race, and was simply being shown as sponsored by the New Jersey Racing Board, and as such was not really a conflict.

J. Rigoli questioned if anyone had looked recently at the NARRC specific classes to determine if there were (or should be) any changes. No changes were noted or recommended.

A question arose as to the Regional sequence of hosting the NARRC banquet. In November it was determined that Mo-Hud would host the 2009 banquet at the March 2010 Roundtable (this meeting). This was the case. NNJ merely provided the location.

Since the sequencing is alphabetical, the next Region to host the banquet would be New England at the conclusion of the 2010 season. That would be followed by New York (2011 season) and Northern New Jersey (2012 season).
